- 1. The licence holder will ensure all members of staff are trained in the requirements of the Licensing Act and other relevant legislation.
- 2 Notices shall be prominently displayed near all exits from the premises asking patrons to leave with consideration for neighbours.
- 3. Persons under 16 years will be accompanied by an adult in the area where licensable activities take place.

- 4. CCTV to be installed in accordance with Home Office Guidelines relating to UK Police Requirements for Digital CCTV System. Images shall be retained for at least 28 days and except for mechanical breakdown beyond the control of the proprietor, shall be made available upon request to the police where it is necessary to do so for the prevention or detection of crime; for the prosecution or apprehension of offenders; or where the disclosure is required by law. Any breakdown or system failure will be notified to the police immediately & remedied as soon as practicable. It will be the responsibility of the DPS to ensure that any request from the police for a recording to be made for evidential purposes.
- 5. All staff that are employed in the sale or supply of alcohol shall receive training prior to employment with the company and further training every three months thereafter. All training records shall be made available to Sussex police upon request.
- 6. A written record of all incidents of crime and disorder will be maintained daily with the records made available to Sussex Police upon requested.
- 7. The premises will adopt a 'Challenge 25' policy whereby any person attempting to buy alcohol who appears to be under 25 will be asked for photographic ID as proof of their age. The only ID that will be accepted are valid passports and UK driving licences with a photograph or proof of age cards bearing the 'PASS' mark hologram
